AOP TERRASSES DU LARZAC



Varieties Carignan, Syrah, Grenache

These vineyard parcels are on slight slopes at the base of the Cévennes mountains. The soils are calcareous clays with varying amounts of small to medium stones, meaning the vines require no irrigation - well suited to our Carignan and Syrah vines. The parcels used for our Accords range Terroir/ have vines that express a good balance between vine growth and grape production, meaning Viticulture that there is a moderate amount of crop which has optimum exposure to the sun. Management is proactive rather than reactive to minimise the number of interventions needed. The Carignan vines are over 60 years old and are truly in balance with their environment. Crafted in small open top fermenters, hand plunged daily, but left on skins for 2 weeks post ferment and pressed off when each parcel reached the perfect balance. Aged in demi-muid and Winemaking old barriques to allow the fruit to fully express itself. Generous ripe and rich summer fruit with hints of spice and herbs dominate the aromas. The Tasting Notes palate is elegant, but full flavoured, with supple tannins and a complex lingering finish. Try pairing with roasted stuffed mushrooms, slow cooked roasted beef with a red wine reduction, Food Matches grilled autumn vegetables with balsamic vinegar or enjoy with aged hard cheeses.
